

## **Student Support Services**

Student Support Services (SSS) is a federally funded program that provides opportunities for academic development, assists students with basic college requirements, and serves to motivate students towards the successful completion of their post-secondary education.

SSS is funded by the United States Department of Education to increase college retention and graduate rates of its participants and facilitate the process of transition from one level of higher education to the next.

Students can apply to become a participant at any point in their undergraduate career and at any point in the semester. Participation in the program is on a first-come, first-served basis. Student Support Services offers participants a variety of resources to promote academic success including, but not limited to:

- Tutoring in requested subjects (group or one-on-one settings)
- Preparation for successful entry into the job market with career planning
- Preparation for graduate school
- Participation in SSS sponsored cultural events
- Workshops in a variety of areas to strengthen personal, professional, and academic competencies including time management, test taking techniques, study skills, and stress management
